AN ELECTRIFYING EXPERIENCE

Submitted by Village of Richfield Springs Historian Harriett Geywits

In 1952, New York State Electric and Gas Corporation celebrate their one hundred years of utility service in this area. An article in the local MERCURY tells of some of the history of the development of this corporation and life in the past without, what was then the astonishing and terrifying, use of electricity in our lives.

“Utility service began in an effort to provide cheaper and more efficient lighting for streets, businesses and homes to replace expensive and unsatisfactory candles and kerosene lamps.

Like most upstate communities, Richfield Springs depended on wood, coal and petroleum products for lighting, cooking, water heating and other vital services in the home. In the kitchen, the housewife heated her dishwater or wash water in a large boiler on the coal or wood range that filled the kitchen with its heat. When the sun went down in those days, light was provided by pungent kerosene lamps or even candles. The streets had only the moon, supplemented by the dim light of oil or naphtha. It was many

years after 1852, the date New York Electric and Gas’ parent company was founded in Ithaca, before Richfield Springs was able to enjoy modern electric lighting.

Laboratory experiments by Michael Faraday had

established the principles of electric generators as early as 1842. A practical machine was not built until 1873, however, and in the United States, Charles F. Brush, one of the first great electrical inventors, built a generator and arc lighting system in 1873. The Brush lights were seen in many communities. At the same time, Edison developed his incandescent lamp that did more than any single invention to change this country’s living habits.

Wiring in the early days consisted of insulated wires fastened onto walls and woodwork carrying current to a single drop light in each room. The bulb gave only 16 candlepower, a bulb that gives about the same amount of light as a modern 15-watt bulb.

First electric service was charged for at a flat rate according to the number of lamps used and was very expensive by present standards. As late as 1913, the national average for residential electric service was more than 8 1/2 cents per kilowatt hour.

Richfield Springs got its first electric lights after careful consideration by a group of local citizens as to the best type of electric lighting available. On March 3, 1888, the Richfield Springs Electric Light Company was formed and on March 8, 1888, a resolution was presented to the Board of Trustees in favor of electric street lighting. The resolution was passed unanimously, and two men were appointed to look over electric lighting plants in Cooperstown, Clayton and Oneonta. Cooperstown was using the Edison system with Clayton and Oneonta employed the American Arc lighting system with Westinghouse alternating current system for the incandescent lights. It was the opinion of the committee that the later system required smaller wires than did the direct current system. This was the system selected for the first lighting plant.



Orders were duly placed for an arc light generator with a capacity of 50 lamps of 2000 candlepower, an unusually brilliant lamp for those days.

Another generator for the incandescent lamps with a capacity of 650 lights was also ordered. the wiring system was built to handle twice that many lamps, however.

Wiring was done in those days at the expense of the company and the newspaper files show the new company had enough applications for service on hand to ensure its success even before the steam engines and generators were installed. The power plant was located at the site of the Dana Mills which was on the west end of Main Street.” Power was furnished by the water of Ocquoionis Creek. The upper two stories and later an addition to the building housed the Richfield Springs Scotch Cap Co. which gave residents year-round employment. The steam from the electric plant was used for power for the Cap Company.

The lights were first turned on June 21, 1888 and the MERCURY carried the following report: ‘Considering the fact that the machinery was all new, the service was pronounced first class in every particular. The places using them could easily detect the difference in the atmosphere during the hot wave. The electric light company was met with liberal patronage, enough so the full capacity of the dynamo (generator) is taken, and another will undoubtedly have to be put in next year. Those who are using the lights express great admiration for it is bound to come into general use.’

Among the first subscribers to electric service were St. John’s Church with 49 fixtures; the Darrow House, one of the leading hotels, with 59; barber Chris Nadley with 6; Peckham Hardware had 6 and H. D. Luce had one in his law office.

“In 1913, electric service in Richfield Springs was taken over by the Colliers Light, Heat and Power Company. This company had a hydro-electric plant. A change in the local system which was 25 cycles was made to 60 cycles. In 1924, electric service to this area became a part of the present New York State Electric and Gas.”

We can only wonder what our ancestors would think if they knew how the present generation has come to rely on a constant source of electricity.

NOTICE OF SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC HEARING AND VOTE

Notice is hereby given that the **Public Hearing** of the inhabitants of the Richfield Springs Central School District of the Towns of Richfield, Springfield, Otsego and Exeter, Otsego County, and Columbia and Warren, Herkimer County, New York, qualified to vote at school meetings in said district will be held at the Richfield Springs Central School in said district on Wednesday, May 6, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. for the transaction of such business as is authorized by Education Law. And notice is also given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year of school purposes, exclusive of public moneys, may be obtained by any taxpayer in the district during the fourteen days immediately preceding the Budget Vote, except Saturday, Sunday, or holidays at the following location during the hours designated: Richfield Springs Central School, hours 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. In addition, the district tax exemption report will be available for review.

Proposition #1- BASIC BUDGET

To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2026/2027 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.

Proposition #2-BUS PURCHASE

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Richfield Springs Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of school buses, including, without limitation, one (1) school bus at an estimated maximum cost of \$180,657, and one (1) minivan-type vehicle at an estimated maximum cost of \$49,478, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$230,135, less trade-in value, if any, and that such cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$230,135 shall be issued, or the School District may enter into an installment purchase contract if the Board of Education determines that it is in the best interest of the School District to finance the purchase in that method.

Proposition #3-PUBLIC LIBRARY BUDGET

SHALL the Board of Education of the Richfield Springs Central School be authorized, pursuant to Education Law, Section 259, to levy and collect an annual tax, year after year, separate and apart from the annual school district budget, in the amount of \$213,903, which shall be paid to the Richfield Springs Public Library for the support and maintenance of the library, with this appropriated amount to be the annual appropriation until thereafter modified by a future vote of the electors of the Richfield Springs Central School District?

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the Clerk of said School District at her office in the Richfield Springs Central School, no later than Monday, April 20, 2026, between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Vacancies on the Board of Education are not considered separate, specific offices; candidates run at large. Nominating petitions shall not describe any specific vacancy upon the Board for which the candidate is nominated; must be directed to the Clerk of the District; must be signed by at least twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the District; must state the name and residence of each signer, and, must state the name and residence of the candidate, and state that the candidate is a qualified voter of the District.

The following vacancy is to be filled on the Board of Education: (1) Three-year term (last incumbent) Brad Smith

Voting for the board vacancy, and the 2026/2027 school budget will take place between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 in the entrance adjacent to the baseball field. Voting will be by voting machine, absentee ballot or early voter ballot.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) a resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the annual vote and election.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots (where applicable) will be obtainable beginning April 21, 2026 between the hours of 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM Monday through Friday, except holidays, from the District Clerk. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00 PM, prevailing time, on Tuesday, May 19, 2026.

A list of persons to whom absentee ballots are issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District in the office of the District Clerk during each of the five business days prior to the day of the annual vote and election between the hours of 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM, and on May 19, 2026, the day set for the election, and said list will be posted at the polling place at the election. Any qualified voter present in the polling place may object to the voting of the ballot upon appropriate grounds for making his/her challenge and the reasons therefore known to the Inspector of Elections before the close of the polls.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that applications for early mail ballots will be obtainable during school business hours from the District Clerk, applications will be accepted by the District Clerk beginning April 21, 2026; completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Early mail ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 pm, prevailing time, on May 19, 2026.

A list of persons to whom early mail ballots are issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District in the office of the District Clerk during each of the five business days prior to the day of the annual vote and election between the hours of 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM, and on May 19, 2026, the day set for the election, and said list will be posted at the polling place at the election.


AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that military voters who are qualified voters of the Richfield Springs Central School District may request an application for a military ballot from the District Clerk by mail to District Clerk, P.O. Box 631, Richfield Springs, NY 13439, by email to mshaw@richfieldcsd.org, or fax sent to 315-858-0582. In such request, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application by mail, fax or email. A military voter must return the original military ballot application by mail to the office of the District Clerk at Richfield Springs Central School District, P.O. Box 631, Richfield Springs, NY 13439. In order for a military voter to be issued a military ballot, a valid military ballot application must be received in the office of the District Clerk no later than 5:00 P.M., on April 24, 2026. Military ballot applications received in accordance with the foregoing will be processed in the same manner as a non-military ballot application under Section 2018-b of the Education Law. The application for military ballot may include the military voter's preference for receipt of the military ballot by mail, fax, or email.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, a military voter's original military ballot must be returned by mail to the office of the District Clerk at Richfield Springs Central School District, P.O. Box 631, Richfield Springs, NY 13439. Military ballots shall be canvassed if they are received by the District Clerk before 5:00 p.m. on May 19, 2026, and signed and dated by the military voter and one witness thereto, with a date which is ascertained to be not later than the day before the election.

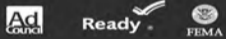

Eco-friendly lawn care can be easy

Homeowners know that a healthy lawn can add considerable curb appeal to a property while giving residents of the home a place to relax and enjoy the great outdoors. But few might know that a healthy lawn can also benefit the environment, especially when homeowners take a proactive approach to lawn care that emphasizes eco-friendly techniques.

A proactive approach to lawn care can prevent certain problems, including disease, insect infestation and weed growth. When such problems arise, many homeowners opt to combat them with pesticides, which can harm the environment. But a proactive approach to lawn care can reduce the likelihood of developing such problems and protect the planet at the same time.

- **Emphasize healthy soil.** Healthy soil promotes strong roots, which leads to a more robust, lush and aesthetically appealing lawn. While a lawn needs to be fertilized in the spring and at various points throughout the summer, it's important that homeowners avoid overfertilization, which can create thatch that, when allowed to thicken, will prevent nutrients from penetrating the soil. Lawns need more nitrogen, phosphorous and potassium than soil can typically provide, so fertilizing throughout the warm weather seasons and into early fall can promote a healthy lawn. But choose a slow-release fertilizer so it gradually feeds the lawn. Compost and grass clippings can also be spread around the lawn to promote healthy soil. The pH level of the soil should also be checked to ensure the lawn can fully absorb nutrients. Speak with a local lawn care professional to determine what a healthy pH level is for soil in your area.

- **Choose a grass that can thrive in your climate.** Though you might prefer the look of a certain grass, choosing a grass based entirely on appearance is a mistake that could cost you money and prove harmful to the environment. When installing a new lawn, opt for one that's suitable to the local climate. Installing a lawn that needs substantial amounts of water in a region known for drought can rob the lawn of its aesthetic appeal and will cost homeowners a substantial

amount of money to maintain. If an existing lawn struggles to stay green regardless of your best efforts, then consider replacing it with a new type of grass that might be more suited to the local climate.

- **Don't cut too low when mowing.** Homeowners who don't enjoy mowing their lawn might be tempted to simply cut the grass as low as possible to extend the intervals between cuts. But the United States Environmental Protection Agency recommends that grass never be cut more than one-third of the height of the grass blades. Longer grass can take in more sunlight, allowing it to grow in thicker and develop a deeper root system. That deep root system can help a lawn survive drought and prevent disease, two potentially costly problems that often force homeowners to embrace solutions that are not eco-friendly. Ideal lawn height depends on the type of grass, so consult a lawn care professional to ensure you are cutting your grass to a healthy length.

- **Avoid overwatering.** Excessive watering not only wastes water, which is not very eco-friendly, but also hurts the lawn when dry periods inevitably arrive. That's because shallow and frequent watering encourages roots to stay near the surface, so when dry periods arrive, the roots struggle to find water. The EPA notes that an established lawn should not need daily watering. Instead, watering responsibly when the lawn needs water and when evaporation can be kept to a minimum, can strengthen a lawn and do so in an eco-friendly way. GT144076
