THE AMERICANIZATION CAMPAIGN

“Give me your tired, your poor, your huddled masses yearning to be free...” These are the well-known words written in 1883 by Emma Lazarus in *The New Colossus*, a sonnet she penned to raise funds for the construction of the pedestal for the Statue of Liberty. She imagined Lady Liberty welcoming immigrant refugees who were fleeing persecution and seeking asylum in America.

These words held special meaning to those who settled in our area after World War I. At that time, there was an influx of those of Polish nationality who were welcomed with meetings set up to help them learn about America and become citizens of their new country. Those participating in these Americanization Committee meetings included, among others, the American Legion, D. A. R., Granges and schools. One such meeting was held in 1922 in Cullen and reported in *THE MERCURY*.

“When Richard Owen, agent for the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, saw upon looking into the windows of the little school at Cullen, a succession of moving American flags, an idea was born that resulted in a splendid Americanization meeting in that same schoolhouse. Mr. Owen entered the school and found nineteen children, each holding an American flag, going through a drill. The teacher, Mrs. Pearle Zoller, stated that she was teaching them to be Americans. One little chap could not speak English, but he could sing ‘America’. Both being intensely interested in the Americanization of our foreign population, Mr. Owen and Mrs. Zoller thereupon planned a special meeting with a program consisting of drills by the children and speeches by several residents of Richfield Springs.

The nineteen little children, their teacher, their mothers and fathers and a number of interested men and women filled the building to capacity for the program that included three drills by the pupils, short speeches by James McKee, John A. Losee, W. T. Welden, C. E. Ackerly, Miss Reed who represented the D.A.R. and Andrew Hommiack, with longer talks by Senator Allen J. Bloomfield and John D. Cary.

‘Make the land in which you have established your home, your new country’ was the theme of the addresses. Senator Bloomfield impressed upon his hearers the duties of citizenship. He dwelt at length upon the unselfishness of the ideal citizen and Mr. Cary told the children, in his entertaining way, a story illustrating and emphasizing the unwanted results of being selfish.

Andrew Hommiack, a native of Poland, made a telling speech in English saying that he had come to this land of the free to escape serving in the army for three years at six cents a day and wanted to become a citizen of this great country which offered to him, and to his fellow people, a haven from oppression and where opportunity was not limited.”

A second meeting was held that year in the Memorial Room of the Public Library advertised as being for the enlightenment and encouragement of our friends from Poland. It was held under the direction of Mr. Owen. It was reported that many Polish men and women were present in addition to residents of the village and community as well as a representation from Ganowauges Chapter D.A.R. Mrs. Zoller brought her children from the school at Cullen. Among the speakers were Mr. Owen, Village President Caney, Senator Allen J. Bloomfield, Supt. Mulhall of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Utica, and Mr. Szypulsky, a Polish banker from Utica. The last named spoke in the native Polish tongue.



“The meeting could not have failed to have done very much good in the matter of the purpose of creating in the minds of the foreigners in this section, the desire to become naturalized American citizens. Mr. Owen, in his opening speech, said that the keynote of the meeting was that we should understand one another and get a correct attitude toward each other - that thirty years ago there were only two Polish farmers in this vicinity and now, over thirty percent of the milk brought to the station was furnished by Polish farmers. Speaking to the many foreigners in the audience, he gave them a hearty welcome.

Village President Caney said that he wished the work of the committee great success and could not help thinking how pleased the donor of the building (T. R. Proctor) would be if he knew it was being used for this work. He stated: ‘You come to this country for a home, for land, for freedom of education and religion and we want you to receive the full benefit of these things by becoming citizens of your new country.’

Senator Bloomfield said: ‘We are all neighbors and friends. Although a man be silent in spoken word, he has at heart, a sense of brotherhood and respect for you and your work. If this country is ever to be involved in any great program of Americanization we, as a country and people, ought to know something about the strength, the character and achievements of each race and thus learn if there are problems where we can be of help.’

The Senator gave some interesting statistics. The people of Polish extraction in the United States would populate the five New England states, not including Massachusetts, as they are now inhabited. In New York, the population is 1 to 14; in Massachusetts 1 to 12; in Pennsylvania 1 to 10 and in Michigan and Wisconsin, 1 to 8. In the city of Chicago, there is a Polish population second only to Warsaw itself. These figures indicate the great rapidity with which the Polish people are assuming the position of an important section of our population. You are by instinct and tradition, an agricultural people and it is a good thing for us that you do love the land. You are a courageous people - 40,000 enlisted in the American army and 220,000 fought for America in the World War. You are a thrifty people and that solidarity is found today on the farms. My definition of citizenship in one word is ‘usefulness’. A true citizen is that man or woman who represents to himself or herself in daily action and life, the ideals and principles for which America stands. You came here for freedom to live, to think, to develop, to grow and you must serve others that follow, seeing that they have these freedoms, too.”

The Americanization meetings continued throughout the years, offering classes to all immigrants to prepare them for citizenship in the country where they chose to establish their roots for a new life.



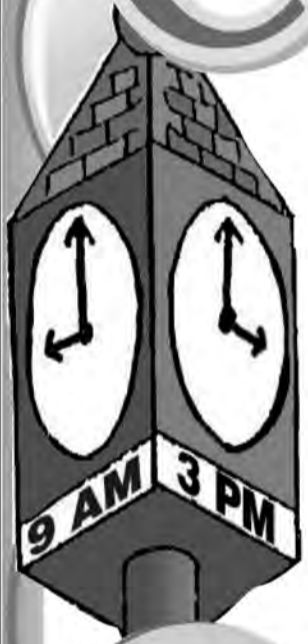

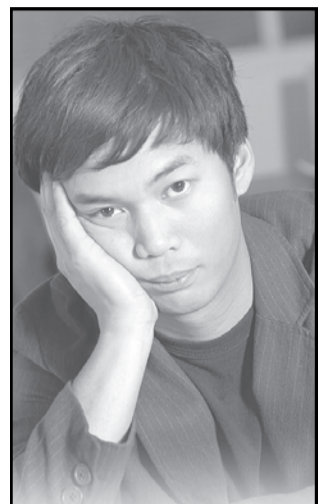
